### NATURE OF CALL:

At approx. 0820 hours on 2/4/12, I was dispatched to a B & E complaint at 310 S. Francis. Upon my arrival, I made contact with the complainant, Sheri Ward.

### VICTIM STATEMENT:

Sheri Ward resides at 310 S. Francis. Sheri stated that her home was broken into while she was gone this morning. Sheri stated that she secured her residence when she left at approx. 0735 hours. Sheri stated that she left this morning to pick up her friend, Jennifer Scott, who called and asked for a ride to the Quality Dairy. When she returned home at approx. 0815 hours with Jennifer, she found the front door of the residence kicked in. Sheri stated the unknown suspect(s) stole the 52" flat screen TV from the entertainment stand in the living room. The suspect(s) attempted to take the smaller flat screen TV located in the front bedroom but was unsuccessful. Sheri stated that nothing else was stolen or moved. Sheri stated that there was a cab/cab driver sitting in the lot south of her residence when she left her residence. Sheri also advised that the suspect(s) left a paper bag

containing candles and other misc. items on her front porch. Her friend Jennifer Scott told her that she had seen the same bag sitting on the table at 300 S. Magnolia one day earlier. Sheri stated that she called LPD when she returned home and found the house broken into.

#### STOLEN PROPERTY:

Sharp Aquos 52" flat screen TV. Model #: LC52LE810UN, Serial #: 006836852. The TV was purchased from Best Buy for \$1200.00.

#### ENTRY/EXIT INFORMATION:

The unknown suspect(s) entered the residence by kicking in the front door of the residence. The suspect(s) exited the residence through the same door.

#### DAMAGED PROPERTY:

The front entry door and the door casing/jam was damage during the incident. The estimated value of the damage was unknown at the time of the initial report.

#### EVIDENCE:

Officer Carey responded to the scene to assist in processing the scene. Officer Carey dusted for latent prints, took photos of the scene and collected a bag that was left by the suspect(s) at the scene. Officer Carey tagged the latent prints in to LPD QM at the north precinct. Officer Carey also tagged in to LPD QM, the bag left behind by the suspect(s) containing the glass candles and other misc. items. The bag and items were noted to be printed at a later time. identified as Woodrow Campbell. Mr. Campbell is employed by the Green cab company, he gave me the following statement.

Woodrow Campbell advised that he was sitting in the vacant parking lot located at Francis/Kalamazoo at approx. 0620 this morning. Woodrow advised that at approx. 0620 hours he noticed two subjects hanging out and walking around the rear of the car wash property that is located on the north east corner of Kalamazoo /Francis. He thought the subjects were acting strange. He described the subjects as two white males, approx. mid 20's, about 5'9", about 150 pounds and one possibly had facial hair. Woodrow stated that both subjects had dark colored hoodie type coats or sweatshirts on with the hoods pulled up and baggy jeans. Woodrow stated that one subject's hoodie had a design on the back, possibly of a dragon or other animal type pattern. Woodrow stated that he lost sight of the subjects for a short period of time.

Woodrow stated that he observed the victim drive by in her vehicle when she left her residence. Woodrow advised that after the victim left, he observed the same two subjects come out from between the houses south of the victim's residence. Woodrow stated that he did not see them carrying anything and that he last saw them walking n/b on Francis towards Michigan.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Sheri heard the description of the subjects and the design on the hoodie and stated that a subject known as Joe Kelly had a hoodie that matched that description. Sheri stated that Joe had been at her house in the past week looking for Stephanie Kirby. Sheri stated that Joe had just been let out of jail for doing B & E's. Sheri stated that Joe hangs out with Stephanie Kirby at [REDACTED]

Jennifer Dawn Scott, w/f, [REDACTED], [REDACTED] Flint, Mi 48504, Tx: [REDACTED]. Jennifer Scott was the individual that Sheri picked up and took to Quality Dairy. Jennifer stated that she had seen the bag sitting on Sheri's front porch at Stephanie Kirby's house on 2/3/12. Jennifer stated that the bag was sitting on the table at the house at [REDACTED]. Jennifer stated that Joe Kelly hangs out at that address with Stephanie Kirby.

Charles Krulik (homeowner) gave consent to check the residence for Joe and the stolen TV. Nothing was located during the search of the residence. The subjects stated that Joe was there last night until approx. 0200 hours. They advised that they kicked him out of the residence because he was acting "crazy". They advised that Joe was last seen wearing a dark purple plaid flannel type coat that had several different colors, a gray hoodie with white writing on it and blue jeans. They stated that Joe had been asking Charles several times during the past week if he wanted to buy a TV for \$400.00.

The subjects had not seen Joe since he left at approx. 0200 hours and advised that they had not seen a TV. They also advised that the bag that had been left on the victim's front porch did not belong to any of them and they had never seen it before. They advised that it looked like something Jennifer Scott would have.

I was contacted by Sheri Ward after talking to the subjects at [REDACTED]. Sheri stated that Joe was also known to hang out at the house located on the south east corner of Foster/Prospect. I went to [REDACTED] and made contact with the home owner who was identified as Gerry Eggleston. Gerry stated that he knew the subject I was asking about as Joe Kelly. Gerry stated that Joe stops by, but does not stay there with him. Gerry stated that he last saw Joe on 2/3/12 at approx. 2230-2300 hours when he was asking to borrow his car. Gerry stated that Joe might be hanging out at a house on Barnes but did not know the address.
