Good morning,

It was brought to my attention yesterday that Michele Ramon has been using the Neighborhood Group that I formed (and registered as a civic organization) back in September of 2018 to post derogatory statements about the city and various council members. I was appalled to hear this.

Additionally, upon further research I discovered that she has hacked into the city's page and removed my name from Foster Farm but is still utilizing my personal home address as the location for this neighborhood group. I find this very disturbing that she was able to go in and change this personal information without my consent or knowledge, and, act as a representative of Foster Farm, when she was NEVER involved with the organization.

She has attempted to duplicate this group and now calls it "Foster Farm & Friends" and has copied pictures from Foster Farm and has added a new email account. The neighborhood group that I started in September of 2018 has only had one meeting (which Michele never attended) and has been inactive after the first meeting. I've included some screenshots from the city's website showing my home address with Michele's name attached to it, and also the original date that I registered Foster Farm as a civic organization. At this point, I feel threatened by Michele, she told me and others, that she is extremely good at hacking into websites and stated to me, "Don't ever make me mad, I can hack into anything and ruin your life and no one will know it's me" I know for a fact that I'm not the only person she has said this too. I don't even know if I am able to delete MY group, Foster Farm, from the city's page because I'm no longer listed under the neighborhood group. I would like to go on the record and state that I have not utilized or been active with Foster Farm after our initial meeting in the fall of 2018. Any comments, statements, events, etc. created by "Foster Farm" or "Foster Farm & Friends" are solely made by Michele Ramon, without consent. I am embarrassed and disgusted with what she has been doing without my knowledge and I have NEVER authorized her to act on behalf of Foster Farm. Please let me know if there is any further information that you need from me regarding this.
