This is in response to your request dated October 7, 2019 under the Freedom of Information Act seeking access to all complaints received since January 2010 in regard to any of these businesses:

- Life Solutions aka Olive Tree Productions 121 NE Capital, Battle Creek MI
- Serenity Point Recovery aka Best Choice Rehabilitation 15140 16th Avenue in Marne, MI
- Behavioral Rehabilitation Services 355 W Mannsiding Rd, Harrison, MI.

In accordance with the FOIA and agency policy, we have searched our records on October 10, 2019.

Your request did not indicate an agreement to pay any fees associated with the processing of your request. However, the Commission's fee regulations specify that fees less than \$25 will be waived. See 16 C.F.R. § 4.8(b)(4). Because the fees associated with the processing of your request did not exceed \$25, we have processed your request free of charge. In the future, please provide a fee agreement to facilitate the processing of your request.

We have located 1 responsive complaint that consumers have made to the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC"). You should know that the enclosed complaint have not necessarily been verified by the FTC. Therefore, you should make your own judgment about relying on the information provided. I am denying access to consumers' names and addresses, and any other identifying information found in the complaints. This information is exempt from release under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), because individuals' right to privacy outweighs the general public's interest in seeing personal identifying information. See The Lakin Law Firm v. FTC, 352 F.3d 1122 (7th Cir. 2003).
